As usual, the meeting opened (and closed) with a prayer – seeking guidance as we work to strengthen MCC Toronto and its community.

- 1. Senior Leadership Update: Several events were and will be held to build community and partnerships including with the Queer Muslim Network, the Trans community and the Toronto Police Services Board (scheduled for June 20). Programs continue to grow for example, the Children's Church is now running every Sunday (except Easter), with some increase in volunteer support. Grants are being sought/secured to assist, including a Canada Summer Jobs Grant as well as another to support human rights programming. After an approximately 4-year hiatus, MCC Toronto held a Healing and Anointing evening service which was very well received including from online viewers who "felt" it. Finally, the staff is in full Pride preparation mode and shared what they need from the Board for the event.
- 2. **Financial Review**: So far, the 2024 operating deficit planned is slightly less which is good news. Note that deficits are typical at this time of year, given the timing of expenses (early in the year for example insurance) and revenues (which tend to be later in the year). This is a reminder of the importance of sustained giving, which provides MCC Toronto with a more even flow of revenues and therefore greater stability.
- 3. **Departmental Presentation**: The Finance Manager provided a financial review of 2023 and shared Hillborn LLP's (the Auditors) communications for approval ahead of being presented at the Annual Congregational Business Meeting (ACBM) on June 9 (we hope to see you there!)

4. Miscellaneous:

 The Board Recruitment committee provided an update on the process to fill vacancies and are pleased with the outcome of the search – which will be presented at the ACBM for congregational approval. MCC Toronto staff continue to work hard to ensure the sanctuary is a place where congregants can enjoy a service free of disturbances. Please remember to silence your phone during service and to use the social hall should you need to use it.
